PLEASE NOTE:

This competition is only open to BAA Northern area and Ireland clubs.

The competition will run from 10.00a.m. to 17.00. However, all competitors must be available to register from 09.00a.m. as follows:

Under 8s and Under 10s – registration between 09.00a.m. and 09:15a.m.

Under 12s and Under 14s – registration between 09.15a.m. and 09:30a.m.

Under 16s, Cadets & Seniors – registration between 09:30a.m. and 09:45a.m.

This is to allow organisers time to readjust any event due to changes in number of competitors on the day.

All Kata will be run on a knock-out flag system.

Judging of Junior Tantō Kakarigeiko and Ninin dori will remain as previously judged, via the points system.

In the event that there are insufficient numbers in the senior events, Kyu and Dan grade events may be merged.

Competitors cannot enter more than one age range per event.
